Purpose and Scope

West Chester University recognizes that students' health, well-being, and development of leadership and communication skills are critical to their success. Intramural Sports at West Chester University is a student-driven program that engages students in organized sports to develop lifelong skills such as teamwork, sportsmanship, and leadership. The Department of Campus Recreation has created an Intramural Sports Manual to provide students with the structural framework necessary to run safe and efficient programs.

Policy Statement

The Intramural Sports Manual contains guidelines governing intramural sports at West Chester University. The Intramural Sports Manual and will be posted on the Campus Recreation website under Intramurals. Guidelines may be adjusted as needed. Intramural Sports guidelines must be approved by the Senior Director of Campus Recreation. This authority may be delegated. Guideline development and changes may occur in consultation with staff and paraprofessional students.

Policy Framework

Intramural guidelines include, but are not limited to registration, eligibility, responsibilities of team captains and sportsmanship set forth by the Department of Campus Recreation.
