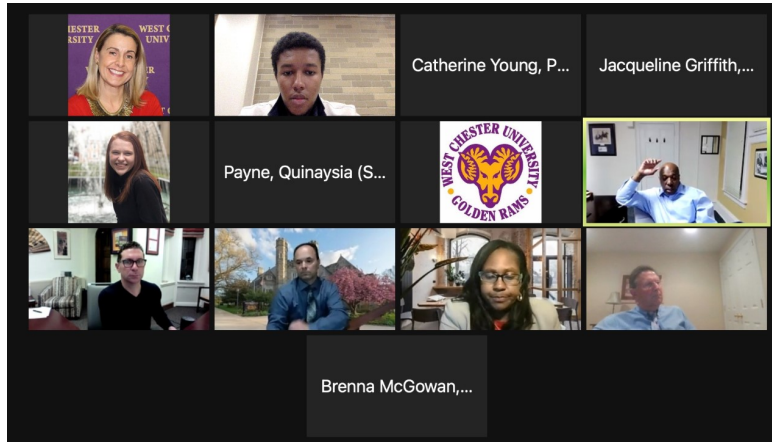




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Student Government Association Hosts Town Hall Featuring the President's Cabinet



(West Chester, PA - October 13, 2021): On Tuesday, October 12 at 7:15 PM the Student Government Association (SGA) hosted a Town Hall via Zoom Webinar featuring the President's Cabinet. Those in attendance were VP of Student Affairs Dr. Zebulun Davenport, Chief Diversity and Inclusion Officer Dr. Tracy Robinson, Deputy Provost Dr. Jeff Osgood, VP of University Affairs Dr. John Vilella, and VP of Finance and Administration Todd Murphy.

Student questions and concerns were submitted beforehand for the cabinet to answer. Topics discussed were issues with Dining Services, On-Campus Housing, Covid-19 Policies, Fraternity and Sorority Life, Parking and Public Safety, and Academic Affairs. SGA President Nebiyou asked submitted questions to the Cabinet, producing answers to students' questions.

Some highlighted questions were about the labor shortage across dining options on campus, the updated mask policy requiring club advisors to be present, and Covid-19 updates. Dr. Davenport spoke on the labor shortages stating that wages have been increased by Aramark and students can apply by emailing wcupiningservices@wcupa.edu. Davenport also addressed the recent mask policy that would have been instated in the coming weeks. After consideration of students feelings and compliance with many clubs, this new policy has been terminated. This will be favorable among many clubs as they can continue to meet without interruption. Lastly, Dr. Osgood stated that WCU is leading in the most controlled Covid-19 cases compared to other PASSHE schools.

The meeting ended with Elias giving clubs and organizations in attendance a quick update on Budgeting Seminars being hosted by SGA Treasurer Hannah Rothman. These are mandatory for the club Treasurer to attend in order for them to be approved for a budget.
