Framed by Nina Simone's song "Four Women," this music-filled contemplation on colorism and black womanhood features popular hits and civil rights anthems by the "High Priestess of Soul." Ham's play imagines a chance encounter between Simone and three other black women amid the rubble of the 16th Street Baptist Church, site of the notorious 1963 bombing that transformed Simone from artist to activist.
