VSA Future Plans Survey Fall 2014: Graduate Program Students

During December of 2014, the Office of Institutional Research of West Chester University of Pennsylvania (WCU) conducted an online survey of students who were intending to graduate with a Master's degree at the end of fall 2014 term. The purpose of the survey was to assess their future plans. The survey consisted of the broad question: "What is the most likely to be your principal activity upon graduation?" as well as, follow-up by questions depending on the graduates' response category. A total of 74 students responded to the survey. This represents approximately 38.3% of the 193 students intending to graduate in December 2014. The findings of the survey are displayed below.



For the 58 survey respondents who indicated employment, full-time as their primary plan after graduation, 43 indicated they had either accepted a position or were continuing on in their current position, 42 out of 43 respondents provided further information on their salary range.
