



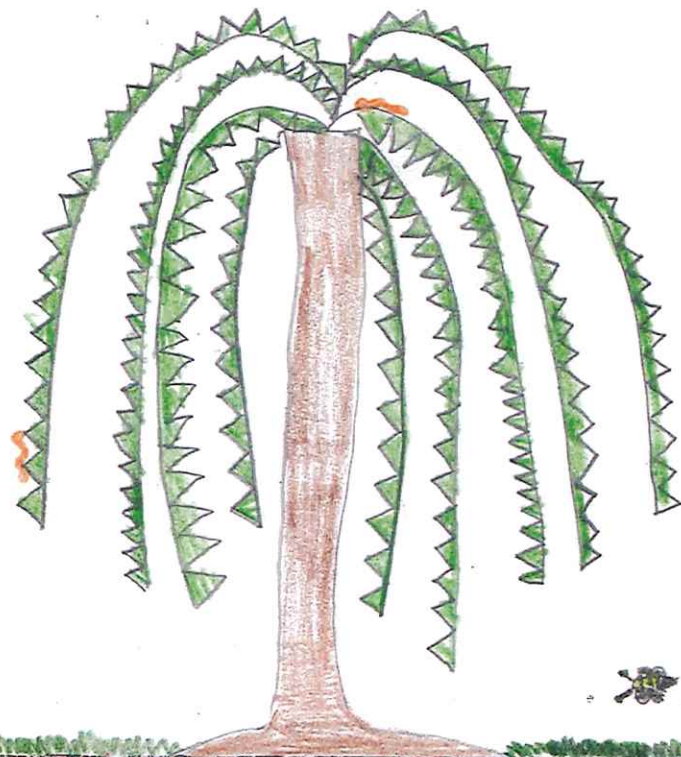

Weeping Willow.

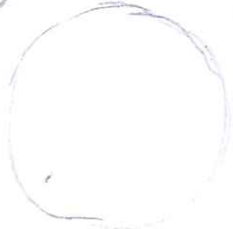

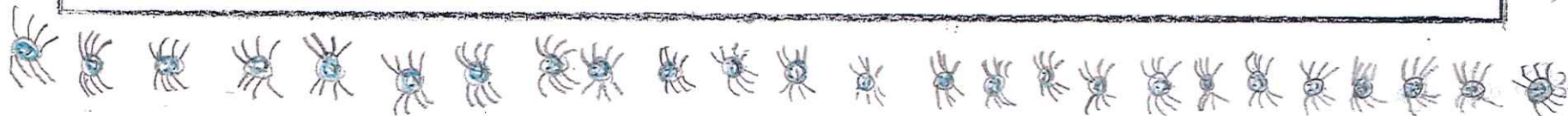
The mystery Plant

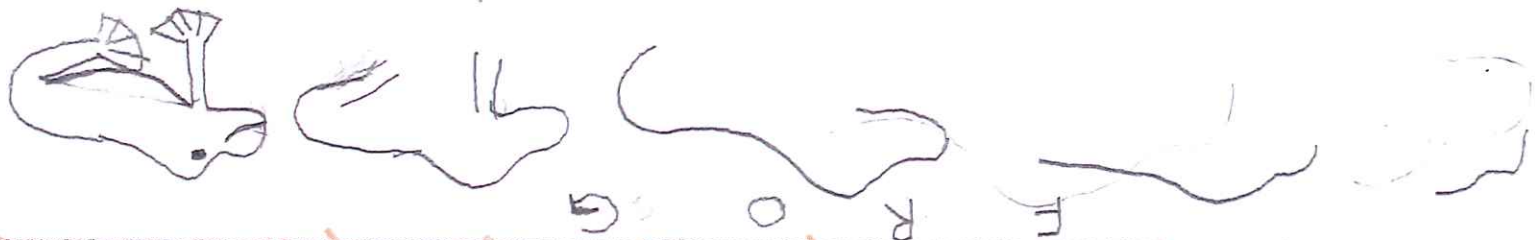

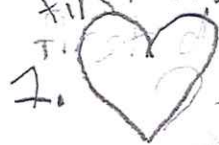

2. an oval & two lines coming out of the end

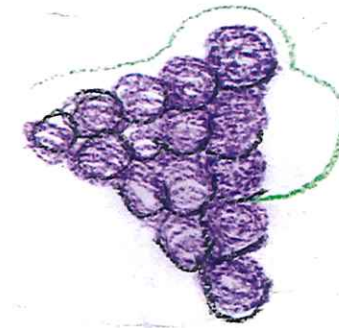


last draw 3. little heart inside the wings & color it in. Now you have a butterfly

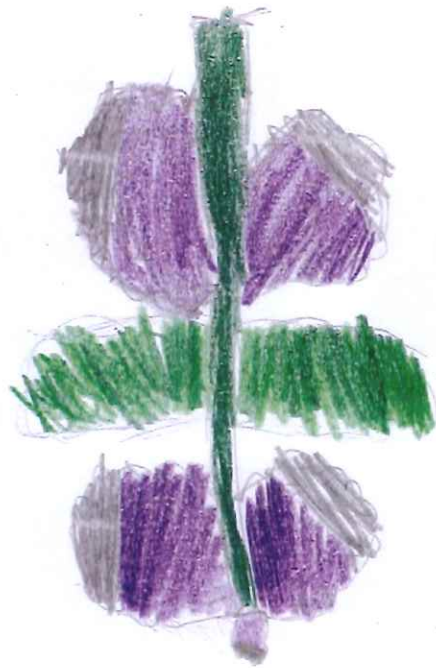


How to draw a bunch of grapes

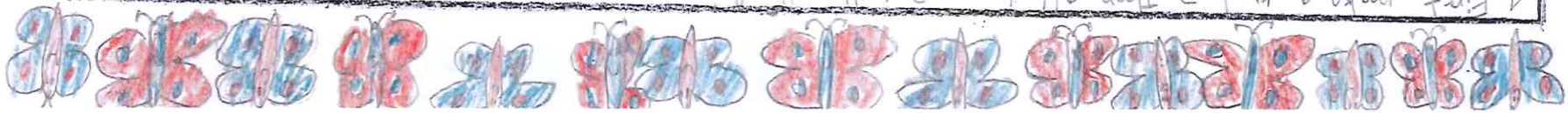

 A chocolate moose cake is my most favorite kind of cake on earth, but when the moose rains away and I start to cry so now my favorite is vanilla.



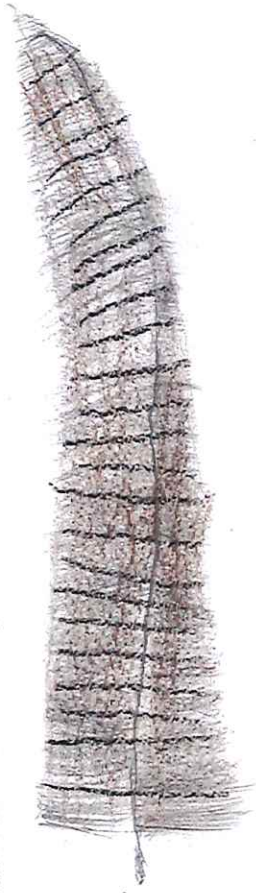
